## 23 encounters with color: landscapes, still lifes, figure paintings

Bowery Gallery is pleased to present an exhibition of recent paintings by John Goodrich. Working freely in oil paint, the artist brings intense, modulated color to 23 landscapes, still lifes and figure paintings.

The artist states:

Painting for me is primarily a visual experience, much as music is an aural one. In any painting, color imparts more than atmosphere; it gives weight to movement. The precedents set by the masters inspire my own struggles to locate character through form—that is, to make objects real within the formal language of paint.
